

How to Crochet an Ear warmer with button up back Designed by Bobwilson123

Video tutorial -







Double Strand of 8ply yarn used with a 6.50 mm hook

OR 1 strand worsted weight yarn and a 5.5mm hook

Sewing needle

Scissors

Button – the button will be big enough to fit the stitches

Measuring tape

US stitches used

Chain – ch

Single crochet – sc

Half double crochet – hdc



Start with a slip knot and make a chain long enough to go around your head to cover your ears, this will differ on each person.

Row 1: sc in the second chain from the hook, sc in the next 9 chains (this makes the narrow area in the back of the head warmer) Put marker in, count back 10 chains on the opposite end of chain and also put in marker, hdc to marker, sc into the last 10 chains, ch 1, turn.

Row 2: (work loosely) slip stitch across to the marker, hdc across in each stitch to the next maker, (work loosely) slip stitch to end of the row. Ch 1, turn.

Row 3: sc in the next 10 st's into the spaces of the sc of row 1 not into the slip stitches, to your marker, hdc across to next marker, sc into the spaces of the sc of row 1 not the slip stitches, Ch 1, turn.

Row 4: slip stitch across to the marker, hdc across to the next marker, slip stitch to end of the row, ch 1, turn.

Row 5: alternating Row 3 and Row 4 until the head warmer is as wide as needed.

If you want to stop the ear warmer from stretching, work a round of sl st around the headband

Sew your button onto the centre of one end.
