



Crochet Ribbed Fingerless Gloves

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EASY

Yarn of your choice as gauge isn't important and hook recommended for yarn

Yarn needle

Scissors

US terms used throughout pattern

Stitches Used:

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

blo = back loop only

st= stitch

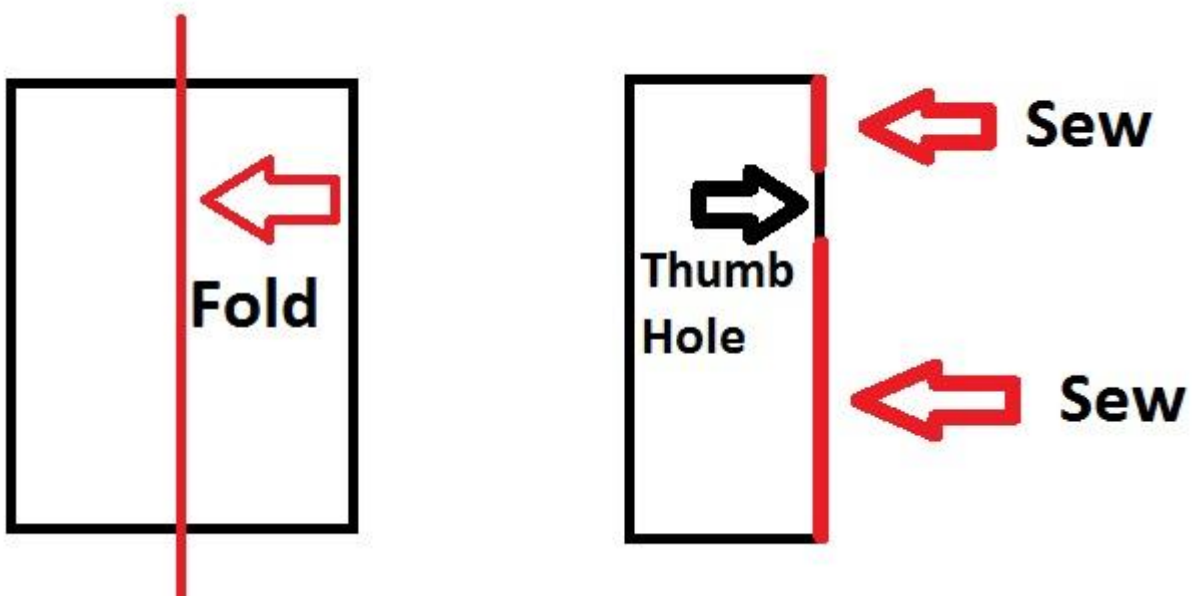
Notes

- The fingerless gloves are made side ways
- The ch 1 is **NOT** counted as the first sc of each row

1. Measure your gloves from your pointer finger knuckle and upwards to your arm for your length required
Once you have your desired length start making chains to this length
1 sc into the 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc into each ch to end, ch 1 and turn

Working each row in the back loop only:

2. Chain 1, 1 sc into the same st, 1 sc into the blo of each sc across, turn
3. Repeat row 2 for width required, break off yarn leaving a long tail for sewing the seam.
4. Using image below - Fold so that the 1st and last row meet, sew up seam until you get to lower thumb joint, (measure as you go) leave thumb opening by weaving yarn through one side of the fingerless glove, then continue to sew glove together for the finger mitt section.
Finish off and sew in your ends
